WHAT OPTIONS ARE AVAILABLE TO ME?

There are many different routes available to you, post 16, depending on how you learn best. At Petroc we provide a variety of courses which will enable you to find something that suits you and your learning style.

A LEVELS: A Levels are Level 3 subjects which are taken over two years. They are ideal if you enjoy a subject at GCSE and want to continue to study it at the next level - and maybe at university in the future. A Level courses are suitable if you enjoy a more academic style of learning.

VOCATIONAL: Vocational courses provide a blend of classroom tuition mixed with practical, hands-on learning and work experience in specific industry areas such as Engineering, Childcare and Hair and Beauty. These include BTECs and T Levels, and are good if you prefer the practical elements of learning as not only will you learn in the classroom, you will also spend time in the workplace environment during your work placement and in our industry standard workspaces.

APPRENTICESHIP: Apprenticeships enable you to carry out a genuine job whilst studying for a formal qualification. They're the perfect combination of hands-on experience and earning a salary - whilst also studying at college. 80% of your time will be spent in the workplace and 20% will be spent in college completing the classroom based learning.

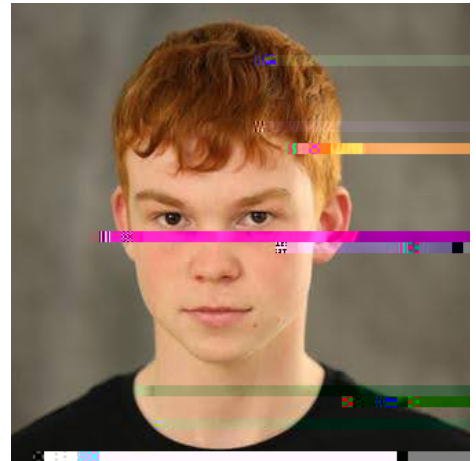
